RESEARCH & PUBLICATIONS:

Over 70 peer reviewed articles and over 80 commissioned articles, editorials and book chapters have been published. Many presentations around the world at various clinical meetings. Details of these in part 2.

TEACHING:

Undergraduate: Working with one of the nurse therapists at the Porterbrook, I am responsible for the direction and some of the delivery of the psychosexual module of lectures and small group seminars. This is within Level 3 Community medicine (University of Sheffield). Several medical students have now had the opportunity for attachment to the psychosexual services in Sheffield.

Postgraduate: Higher trainees in psychiatry, urology and gynaecology are attached to various clinics as part of their training. My post is approved for one year of higher training in psychosexual medicine for SpR posts. Member of faculty – European Academy of Sexual Medicine – first course Oxford July 2007.

Multidiscipline: I regularly teach our students on the postgraduate Masters course on psychosexual therapy. In addition, I teach nursing staff on both an informal and formal basis, and give postgraduate lectures to general practitioners, and other health professionals including psychotherapists, family planning staff and other related disciplines. I supervise a number of MSc students and examine PhD and MD students for other universities.
